1. Agreement to Terms

These Terms of Service (“Terms”) constitute a legally binding agreement between you, whether personally or on behalf of an entity (“you,” “your,” or “Customer”), and Foyer LLC (“Foyer,” “Company,” “we,” “us,” or “our”), concerning your access to and use of the Foyer platform, including the website at usefoyer.com and any related applications, services, or tools (collectively, the “Service”).

By accessing or using the Service, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these Terms. If you do not agree to these Terms, you must not access or use the Service.

We reserve the right to update or modify these Terms at any time. Changes will be effective upon posting the revised Terms with an updated effective date. Your continued use of the Service after any such changes constitutes your acceptance of the revised Terms.

The Service is intended for users who are at least 18 years of age. By using the Service, you represent that you meet this age requirement.

2. Description of Service

Foyer provides a cloud-based platform that enables organizations to manage client interactions, share files, collect information, and collaborate securely. The Service is provided on a subscription basis as described on our website.

3. Account Registration

To use the Service, you must create an account and provide accurate, complete, and current information. You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your account credentials and for all activities that occur under your account. You agree to notify us immediately of any unauthorized use of your account.

We reserve the right to suspend or terminate accounts that contain inaccurate information, or to reclaim usernames at our sole discretion.

4. Free Trial

We offer a 14-day free trial to new users who register for the Service. During the trial period, you may access the Service at no charge. If you do not subscribe to a paid plan before the trial expires, your access to the Service will be suspended. Trial accounts that remain inactive may be deleted after a reasonable period.

5. Fees and Payment

Certain features of the Service require a paid subscription. By subscribing, you agree to pay the applicable fees as described on our website at the time of purchase. All fees are quoted in U.S. dollars unless otherwise stated.

You authorize us to charge your designated payment method on a recurring basis for the subscription term you select, until you cancel your subscription. We reserve the right to change our pricing with reasonable notice. Price changes will take effect at the start of your next billing cycle following the notice.

We reserve the right to correct any errors in pricing, even if payment has already been requested or received.

6. Cancellation and Refunds

You may cancel your subscription at any time through your account settings or by contacting us. Cancellation will take effect at the end of the current paid billing period. No refunds will be issued for partial billing periods.

7. Intellectual Property

The Service, including all software, designs, text, graphics, logos, and other content provided by Foyer (collectively, “Foyer Content”), is the property of Foyer LLC or its licensors and is protected by applicable intellectual property laws. You are granted a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to access and use the Service solely for your internal business purposes in accordance with these Terms.

You may not copy, modify, distribute, sell, lease, reverse engineer, or create derivative works based on any Foyer Content or the Service, except as expressly permitted by these Terms or applicable law.

8. Customer Data

You retain all rights to the data, files, and content that you or your users upload, submit, or transmit through the Service (“Customer Data”). By using the Service, you grant Foyer a limited license to host, store, process, and display Customer Data solely as necessary to provide and improve the Service.

You are solely responsible for the accuracy, quality, and legality of Customer Data and for ensuring that your use of the Service complies with all applicable laws and regulations, including any obligations you may have regarding the data of your own clients or end users.

We will not sell, share, or use Customer Data for purposes other than providing the Service, except as required by law or as described in our Privacy Policy.

9. Acceptable Use

You agree to use the Service only for lawful purposes and in accordance with these Terms. You agree not to:

- Use the Service in any way that violates any applicable federal, state, local, or international law or regulation.

Your use of the Service is also governed by our Privacy Policy, available at usefoyer.com/privacy. By using the Service, you consent to the collection and use of information as described in our Privacy Policy.

13. Copyright Infringement

We respect the intellectual property rights of others. If you believe that any content on the Service infringes upon your copyright, please notify us at support@usefoyer.com with a description of the claimed infringement. We will respond to valid notices in accordance with applicable law.

14. Service Availability

We strive to maintain the availability of the Service but do not guarantee uninterrupted or error-free access. We are not liable for any loss or damage resulting from Service interruptions.

15. Term and Termination

These Terms remain in effect for as long as you use the Service.

We may suspend or terminate your access to the Service at any time, with or without cause, and with or without notice. These Terms and any dispute arising out of or relating to these Terms or the Service shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Wisconsin, without regard to its conflict of law principles.

20. Dispute Resolution

20.1 Informal Resolution

Before initiating any formal proceeding, you agree to first attempt to resolve any dispute informally by contacting us at support@usefoyer.com. We will attempt to resolve the dispute informally for at least thirty (30) days from the date of the initial notice.

20.2 Jurisdiction

If a dispute cannot be resolved informally, any legal action or proceeding shall be brought exclusively in the state or federal courts located in Milwaukee County, Wisconsin. You consent to the personal jurisdiction of such courts and waive any objections to venue.

20.3 Class Action Waiver

You agree that any dispute resolution proceedings will be conducted only on an individual basis and not in a class, consolidated, or representative action.

20.4 Time Limitation

Any claim arising out of or relating to these Terms or the Service must be brought within one (1) year after the cause of action accrues. Claims brought after this period are permanently barred.

21. Electronic Communications

By using the Service, you consent to receive communications from us electronically, including notices, agreements, and disclosures. You agree that electronic communications satisfy any legal requirement that such communications be in writing.

22. Miscellaneous

These Terms, together with our Privacy Policy and any other agreements referenced herein, constitute the entire agreement between you and Foyer regarding the Service. If any provision of these Terms is found to be unenforceable, the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect. Our failure to enforce any right or provision of these Terms shall not constitute a waiver of such right or provision. We may assign our rights and obligations under these Terms without restriction. Nothing in these Terms creates a joint venture, partnership, employment, or agency relationship between you and Foyer. These Terms shall not be construed against Foyer by virtue of having drafted them.
